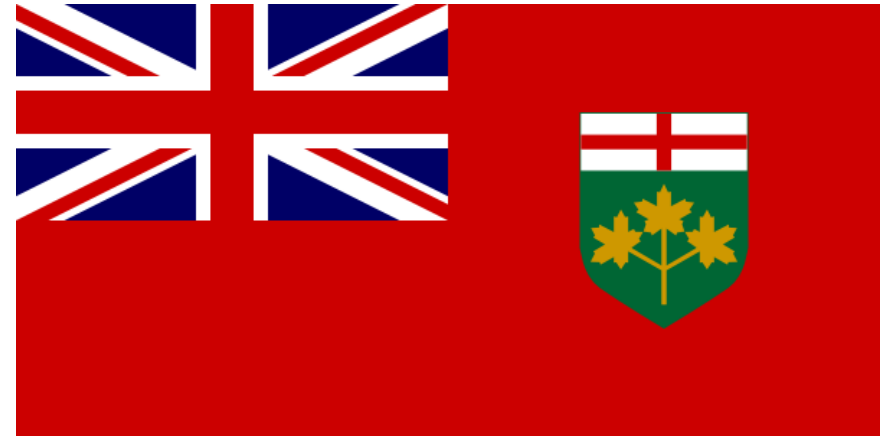

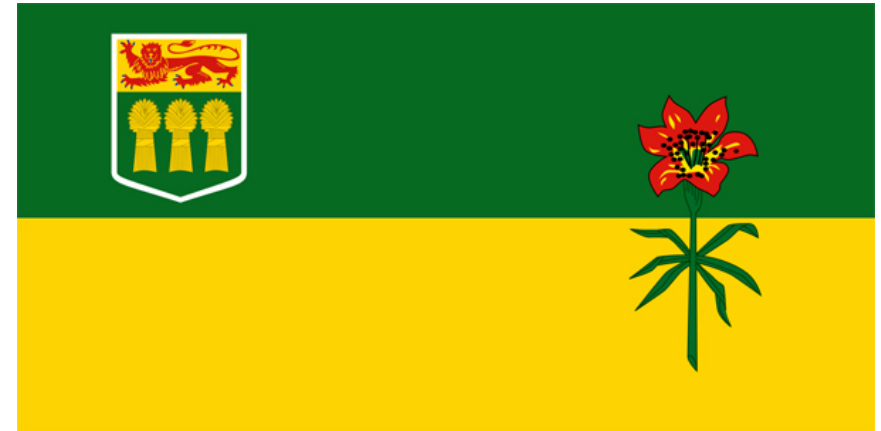

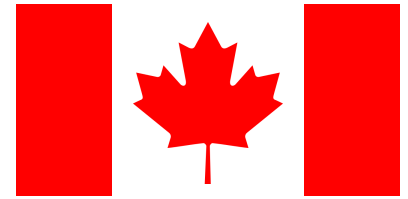


Saskatoon and Saskatchewan C.A.

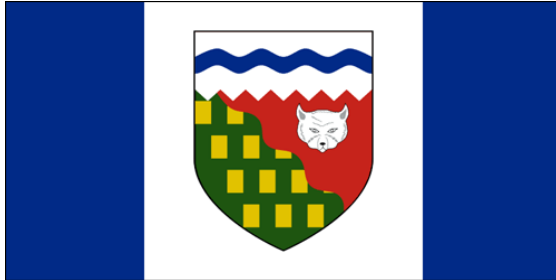
